



IOSH Working Safely

The Institution of Occupational Safety and Health (IOSH) courses have been developed to address the training needs of the non-health and safety expert. Highly successful, the certified courses are delivered to an average of 60,000 people per year. The Online, or CDROM based, 'Working Safely' course is designed to ensure that the learner fully understands their responsibility for ensuring their own health and safety as well as that of other people. The online course follows the same syllabus as that of the classroom based version.
